1. Basic system


Optimisations for accessibility

With the new version, we have further improved accessibility – with additional options for keyboard navigation. For example, the main navigation entries, all tabs, the action buttons in table rows, the language selection on the login page and many other interaction elements can now be accessed with the tab key and selected with the space bar or executed with the enter key. We have also integrated a *Skip to content* link, which allows you to change the focus to the main content area when navigating with the keyboard, if required.

To improve keyboard navigation, we've removed the explicit use of *tabindex* values. This ensures that the tab order - that is, the order in which elements are focused when using the Tab key - corresponds to the natural, intuitive, and visible order. Further improvements to keyboard navigation are coming soon.

Adjustments WYSIWG editor


A new WYSIWYG editor has been available in Blue Ant since version 25.1. When creating tables, the new version also displays the border colour for the table rows correctly (1). By default, all table cells now have a subtle light grey border (2).

In addition, you now have the option of resetting the colour in the colour selection of the WYSIWYG editor (3).

2. Projects

Search for individual fields from status reports

With this version, you can use individual fields from the **project status report** in project search.

Important usage notes:

- The project status report must be saved or sent (manually or automatically) after the update.
- The search always uses **only the most recently saved report**. The report history is not searched.
- To use the fields, add the desired **individual fields from the** *Status Reports* context to the *Projects* search mask and then create a new filter configuration.


The following field types are available for project search:

- Integer
- Decimal number
- Calculation
- List boxes
 - Freely definable fields
 - Default values
- Date / time
- Text field



Usability adjustments to the Gantt filter

We have improved usability in the Gantt view of the project plan. If you filter the project plan, you can now see the number of active filters (1) at a glance on the filter button.




Number of filters selected



3. Administration

Filter options for column and filter templates expanded

In the ADMINISTRATION / CUSTOMISING / TEMPLATES / COLUMNS AND FILTERS screen, the new **Mask / Tab (1)** field is now available for free-text searches. This allows you to specifically search within the *Mask* and *Tab* columns.



Adjustments to the filter and standard sorting

In addition, the table is now sorted by the Mask column (2) in alphabetical order (A–Z) by default.



4. Billing

Extension of field assignments

This version provides you with extensive enhancements to field mappings for electronic invoicing (XRechnung).

- More fields: The number of fields available for export has been significantly increased.
- **Extended logic & hierarchy**: Custom fields from different contexts can now populate the same XRechnung field.

Example:

- Context Invoice: custom field Name (Seller) with report ID INVOICE_E-INVOICE-BT-41
- Context Company division: custom field Name (Seller) with report ID E-INVOICE-BT-41

Both fields populate the same XRechnung field Name (BT-41).

The hierarchy is **Invoice** > **Company** division, meaning the information from the invoice takes priority over the information from the company division.

This logic gives you more flexibility in data entry while ensuring that all required information is fully available in the XRechnung.

5. Interfaces

Jira Connect - technical adjustments

Due to the **deactivation of the previously used endpoint by Atlassian**, Blue Ant now uses a new endpoint to retrieve **JIRA projects**.

- This change has **no impact on existing mappings** in your Blue Ant projects.
- Currently, only **JIRA Cloud systems** are affected.
- For JIRA Data Center, the previous endpoint continues to be used.
